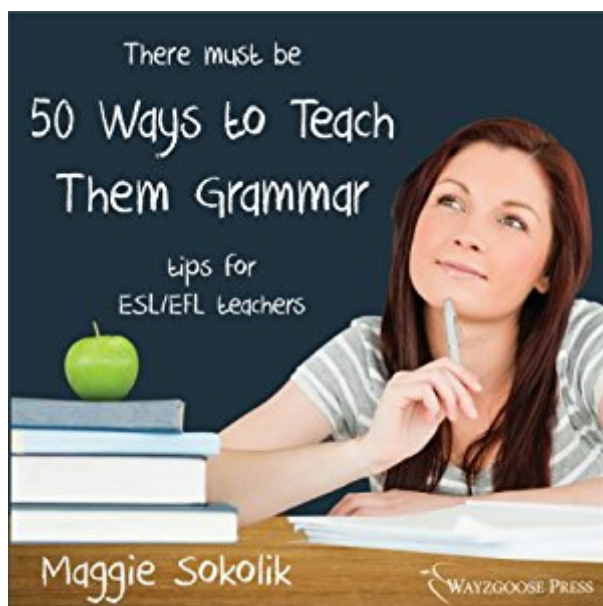

This Book gives 50 varied activities / methods of teaching 50 varied basic grammar points. If I was to describe this book on 1 word it would be "varied". To me it seemed to be a big jumble of ideas

with little coherence in the way of order. The activities mentioned are a varied mix of TS and SS and many of the activities would only last 5 minutes or less in a regular class room. Due to the mixing pot order of the activities sometimes this book was a little difficult to navigate when searching for a specific grammar point. However for a beginner to ESL teaching the kindle version is totally worth the price.

Did not see anything new or exciting in here. The same old ideas that can be found in any basic TEFL course were copied here. Waste of money. Nothing in here you can't find with a simple Google search. The whole series is terrible.
