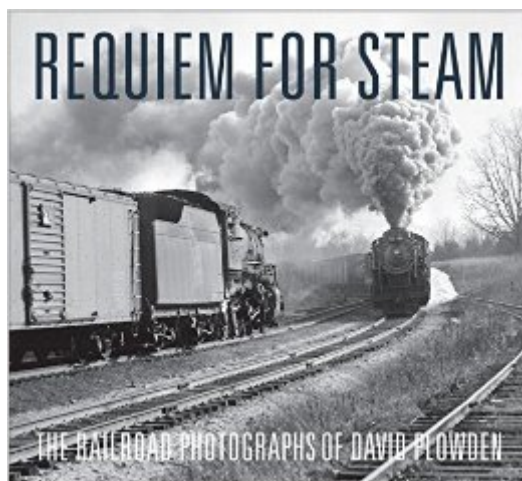

Mr. Plowden's B&W photos are impressive, they are in the same class as those of O. Winston Link or Ansel Adams. Equally impressive is Mr. Plowden's style of descriptive writing. He takes us back to those days, describing things in exquisite detail and we get the complete sensation of what it was like, telling us of all the smells, sights and sensations that were part of the Steam Locomotive era. Many of the photos are from the last days of steam on the Canadian Pacific Railroad, However his photos are not limited to just the CP. Indeed there are pictures on the GN and various Midwestern and eastern locales as well. If you like O. Winston Link's books, you will definitely want to add this book to your collection.
