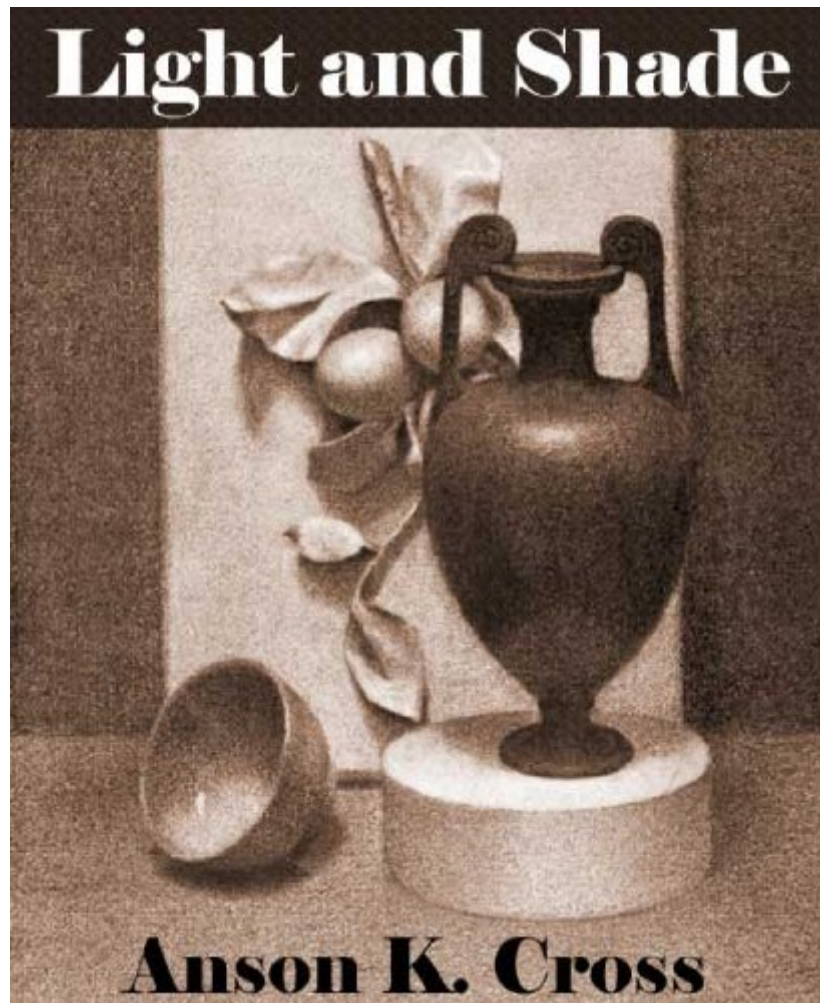

The author's preface to this book is dated October 12, 1896 - in other words the present edition is a re-issue of a book that is over 110 years old! What a wonderful opportunity to learn about art in the pre-computer drawing age and how artists were taught to think about light and shade and the effects on objects. It is a book that doesn't require reading from front to back to get something useful for drawing or painting today. In that pre-television and computer game age, afternoons and evenings might be devoted to art as a pastime instead. Today's great artists like David Hockney are quite capable of drawing highly naturalistically as well as moving on to more abstraction that coming from understanding fundamental forms and light and shadow. A very worthwhile reference source.
